Directions: Take the D or M trains to 18th Avenue to the B-8 bus. Or take the R train to the last stop (95th Street) and take the B-8 to the park. By car, take Exit 4 on the Belt Parkway from either direction. The park will be directly in sight. Make two left turns to find parking.
